## L-Methylfolate Forte 15 mg

### DESCRIPTION

**L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5/15 mg** is a medical food for the dietary management of conditions relating to suboptimal L-methylfolate levels, recommended for use under the supervision of a physician or healthcare provider.

Each **L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5 mg capsule** contains 7.5 mg of L-methylfolate (Metafolin®)\* and 90.314 mg Algae-S Powder (Schizochytrium)\*\*. \*CAS#151533-22-1

#### Other Ingredients:

#### L-Methylfolate 7.5 Dietary Ingredients:

Silicified Microcrystalline Cellulose, Algae-S Powder (Schizochytrium Algal Oil [Vegetable source]), Glucose Syrup Solids, Mannitol, Sodium Caseinate (milk), Soy Protein, High Oleic Sunflower Oil, 2% or less Sodium Ascorbate, Tricalcium Phosphate, Tetrasodium Diphosphate, Natural Flavors, Soy Lecithin, and Mixed Natural Tocopherols and Ascorbyl Palmitate(as antioxidants), Pullulan, Titanium dioxide [color], Magnesium Stearate (Vegetable Source), FD&C Yellow #6[color], FD&C Red #40[color], Propylene Glycol, Sodium Hydroxide, Povidone, FD&C Yellow #6 Aluminum Lake[color], Shellac. **Contains Milk and Soy**

Each **L-Methylfolate Forte 15 mg capsule** contains 15 mg of L-methylfolate (Metafolin®)\* and 90.314 mg Algae-S Powder (Schizochytrium)\*\*. \*CAS#151533-22-1

#### Other Ingredients:

Silicified Microcrystalline Cellulose, Gelatin (Kosher), Titanium Dioxide, Magnesium Stearate (Vegetable Grade), Shellac, Propylene Glycol, Carmine.\*\*\*

\*\*Ingredients in Algae-S Powder (Schizochytrium) include: Schizochytrium Algal Oil (Vegetable Source), Glucose Syrup Solids, Mannitol, Sodium Caseinate (milk), Soy Protein, High Oleic Sunflower Oil, 2% or less Sodium Ascorbate, Tricalcium Phosphate, Tetrasodium Diphosphate, Natural Flavors, Soy Lecithin, and Mixed Tocopherols and Ascorbyl Palmitate.

#### L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5/15 mg contains Milk and Soy.

\*\*\*L-Methylfolate Forte 15 mg contains Carmine as a color additive.

**L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5/15 mg** is labeled as a medical food for use under the active and ongoing medical supervision of a physician or health-care provider on a recurring basis for, among other things, instructions on their use.

Medical foods are intended for the dietary management of a patient who, because of therapeutic or chronic medical needs, has limited or impaired capacity to ingest, digest, absorb or metabolize ordinary foodstuffs or certain nutrients, or who has other special medically determined nutrient requirements, the dietary management of which cannot be achieved by the modification of the normal diet alone.<sup>1</sup> This Medical Food is not subject to NDA or ANDA approval and is not an Orange Book product. Although FDA does not require a prescription for Medical Foods, this product is intended to be used under active medical supervision. This product is not eligible for government reimbursement under federal programs, but is eligible for reimbursement under state programs on a case-by-case basis. Please check with a specific state to determine proper reimbursement eligibility.

### INDICATIONS AND USAGE

**L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5/15 mg** is labeled as a medical food for the distinct nutritional requirements of individuals who have or are at risk for conditions relating to suboptimal L-methylfolate levels.

### CONTRAINDICATIONS

**L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5/15 mg** is contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to any of the components contained in this product.

### PRECAUTIONS

#### General:

Folic acid, when administered in daily doses above 0.1 mg, may obscure the detection of B<sub>12</sub> deficiency. L-methylfolate may be less likely than folic acid to mask vitamin B<sub>12</sub> deficiency.<sup>2,3</sup> Folate therapy alone is inadequate for the treatment of a B<sub>12</sub> deficiency.

#### Patient Information:

**L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5/15 mg** is a medical food recommended for use under the supervision of a physician or health-care provider.

### ADVERSE REACTIONS

Allergic reactions have been reported following the use of oral L-methylfolate.

**Keep this and all medications out of the reach of children. In case of accidental overdose, seek professional assistance or contact a poison control center immediately.**

### DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

The usual adult dose is one capsule given daily with or without food as directed under medical supervision.

### HOW SUPPLIED

**L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5/15 mg** is a medical food recommended for use under the supervision of a physician or health-care provider.

Each **L-Methylfolate Forte 7.5 mg capsule** has an orange cap and opaque white body. It is imprinted with "B" in white ink on the cap and "908" in orange ink on the body.

**L-methylfolate Forte 7.5mg:** Bottles of 90 capsules, Product Code 51991-908-90.‡ Use under medical/physician supervision.

Each **L-Methylfolate Forte 15 mg capsule** has an opaque white cap and opaque white body. It is imprinted with "15" in red ink on the cap and "AG" in red ink on the body.

**L-methylfolate Forte 15mg:** Bottles of 90 capsules, Product Code 51991-909-90.‡ Use under medical/physician supervision.
